NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids entitled;

Project Name: INSTALLATION OF OBSERVATION WELLS

will be received at The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (Brick Utilities), 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, New Jersey, up to **Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.**, and publicly opened and read aloud by the Resident Engineer. No bids will be accepted after said prevailing time and day.

The proposed work consists of but is not limited to;

A. The proposed work consists of but is not limited to;

- Install two (2) observation wells at the Brick Utilities Main Facilities Campus at 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick Township, NJ 08724-2399.
- Obtain well drilling permits from NJDEP.
- Testing and disinfection of new wells.
- Geophysical Logs.
- Installation of well pumps, controls and electric service
- Pump testing of wells.
- Restoration of site.
- Appropriate soil erosion and sediment control features to be deployed on site prior to the start of construction and maintained during construction such as inlet filters for the existing storm sewer inlets and silt fences.

B. Prior to submitting a Bid, and before starting work, the Contractor shall visit the site and note the conditions under which the work will be performed. Failure to visit the site shall not relieve the contractor of his responsibility to perform his work.

C. The entire work covered in these specifications and on contract drawings shall be constructed and finished in every respect in a good, workmanlike, substantial manner. All parts necessary for the proper and complete execution of the work, whether the same have been specifically mentioned or not, or indicated on the drawings, shall be furnished and installed in a manner corresponding with the rest of the work as if the same were particularly described and specifically provided for therein. It is not intended that the drawings shall show every detail, piece of material or equipment; but such parts and pieces as may be necessary to satisfactorily complete any system in

accordance with the best practices and regulatory requirements, even though not shown, shall be furnished and installed. All materials and equipment shall be new unless specifically stated otherwise in these contract documents.

The proposed work is located;

Brick Township Utilities Main Facilities Campus at 1551 Highway 88 West in Brick Township, Ocean County, NJ.

Note: *This project is not funded by the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB).*

Each prospective bidder will have to provide the appropriate installation references and certifications to the satisfaction of the Owner.

Bids must be submitted on forms prepared by Brick Utilities. All bids must be enclosed in sealed, specially addressed envelope bearing on the outside the name and address of the bidder and work bid upon. All envelopes should be sent to the attention of the Engineering Department.

Specifications may be obtained by bona fide bidders upon application at the office of Maser Consulting P.A., 331 Newman Springs Road, Suite 203, Red Bank, NJ 07701, on or after Tuesday, July 3, 2018, upon payment of \$100.00 per set. Checks should be made payable to the order of Maser Consulting P.A., shall be non-refundable and no refunds will be made for return of complete or partial contract documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Check for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid or a maximum of \$20,000.00; such certification to be without condition or qualification, and the check made payable to The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority. Each bid must also be accompanied by an agreement to become surety, properly executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey and which agreement shall be attached to the proposal.

All bidders shall be required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, requiring each bidder and each subcontractor to formulate and submit to the proper authorized representative of the State of New Jersey an affirmative action program of equal opportunity which guarantees minorities employment in all categories.

If a bidder is a corporation or a partnership, the bidder, in conformance with Chapter 33, P.L. 1977, shall submit with his bid a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders who own a ten percent (10%) or greater interest in the firm.

The Project shall conform to the Local Public Contract Law, P.L. 1971, Chapter 198, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq.

Brick Utilities reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any and all bids, if, it is in the public interest to do so.
