NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids entitled;

**RESERVOIR INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
CAPITAL PROJECT NO. 718010X
NJIB PROJECT NO. 1506001-016**

will be received at The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (Brick Utilities), 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, New Jersey, up to **December 3, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.**, and publicly opened and read aloud by Brick Utilities. No bids will be accepted after said prevailing time and day.

Provide the labor, equipment & materials to properly remediate the existing sand covered reservoir sloped surfaces to receive a stabilization utilizing a concrete filled geotextile mattress that will be placed on the side slopes and ledge of the reservoir. This scope of work will also include the earthwork, sub-grade preparation, placement of stabilization matting, concrete work, and placement of soil erosion measures, and any incidental restorations.

Each prospective bidder will have to provide the appropriate installation references and certifications to the satisfaction of the Owner.

A Pre-Bid Meeting has been scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on November 7, 2024 at Brick Utilities Main Conference Room in the Administration Building at the aforementioned address. Following the Pre-Bid Meeting, all interested parties will be escorted to the project location for a site inspection. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Meeting is highly recommended.

Bids must be submitted on forms prepared by Brick Utilities. All bids must be enclosed in sealed, specially addressed envelope bearing on the outside the name and address of the bidder and work bid upon. All envelopes should be sent to the attention of the Brick Utilities Engineering Department at 1551 Highway 88 West, Brick, New Jersey 08724.

Plans and specifications may be obtained by bona fide bidders upon application at the office of Colliers Engineering and Design, 101 Crawfords Corner Road, Suite 3400, Holmdel, NJ, on or after November 1, 2024, upon payment of \$200.00 per set. Checks should be made payable to the order of Colliers Engineering and Design, shall be non-refundable and no refunds will be made for return of complete or partial contract documents.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or Certified Check for an amount equal to ten percent (10%)

of the bid or a maximum of \$20,000.00; such certification to be without condition or qualification, and the check made payable to The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority. Each bid must also be accompanied by a Consent of Surety, properly executed by a surety company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey or permitted individual and shall be attached to the proposal.

All bidders shall be required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-6.2, requiring each bidder and each subcontractor to formulate and submit to the proper authorized representative of the State the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development an affirmative action program of equal opportunity which guarantees minorities employment in all employment categories.

The bidder is a corporation, a partnership or a limited liability company, the bidder, in conformance with N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2, shall submit with his bid a statement setting forth the names and addresses of all stockholders in the corporation who own 10 percent or more of its stock, of any class, or of all individual partners in the partnership who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, or of all members in the limited liability company who own a 10 percent or greater interest therein, as the case may be. If one or more such stockholder or partner or member is itself a corporation or partnership or limited liability company, the stockholders holding 10 percent or more of that corporation's stock, or the individual partners owning 10 percent or greater interest in that partnership, or the members owning 10 percent or greater interest in that limited liability company, as the case may be, shall also be listed. The disclosure shall be continued until names and addresses of every noncorporate stockholder, and individual partner, and member, exceeding the 10 percent ownership criteria established in this act, has been listed. To comply with this section, a bidder with any direct or indirect parent entity which is publicly traded may submit the name and address of each publicly traded entity and the name and address of each person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest in the publicly traded entity as of the last annual filing with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission or the foreign equivalent, and, if there is any person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest, also shall submit links to the websites containing the last annual filings with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission or the foreign equivalent and the relevant page numbers of the filings that contain the information on each person that holds a 10 percent or greater beneficial interest.

This contract or subcontract is expected to be funded in part with funds from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank. Neither the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank nor any of their departments, agencies or employees is, or will be, a party to this contract or subcontract or any lower tier contract or subcontract. This contract or subcontract is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 7:22-3, 4, 5, 9 and 10.

The successful Bidder will be required to comply with N.J.A.C. 7:22-9.1 et. seq. for the participation of small business enterprises owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDs). The Contractor and all subcontractors will be required to comply with the SED Utilization Plan developed by Brick Utilities for fulfilling SED requirements.

The Project shall conform to the Local Public Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq. The bid receipt date will be at least thirty (30) days after the advertisement date; addenda notices will be provided no less than seven (7) days, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted, prior to the bid receipt deadline.

Brick Utilities reserves the right to waive any minor informalities or non-material exceptions/defects in a bid. Brick Utilities reserves the right to reject any bid containing a material defect(s) and further reserves the right to reject all bids under any circumstances set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2
