



Construction of upgrades and improvements to The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority's Manhole Rehabilitation and Replacement project, Loan amount of \$8,525,000.00, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will provide water quality benefits; ensuring that the sanitary sewer infrastructure is in good condition, reducing sanitary sewer failures for residents and businesses throughout Brick Township.
