# 2010/2011 Authority Budget Resolution — Water FISCAL YEAR: FROM APRIL 1, 2010 TO MARCH 31, 2011

January 25, 2010

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget for the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority for the fiscal year beginning, April 1, 2010 and ending, March 31, 2011 has been presented before the governing body of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority at its open public meeting of January 25, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$16,589,760, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit if any, of \$17,088,187 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets utilized of \$498,427; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$5,442,452 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$4,725,514; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rates, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority, at an open public meeting held on January 25, 2010 that the Annual Budget, including appended Supplemental Schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority for the fiscal year beginning, April 1, 2010 and ending, March 31, 201 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the said Authority's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

FISCAL YEAR: FROM APRIL 1, 2010 TO MARCH 31, 2011

1. Complete a brief statement on the 2010 proposed Annual Budget and make comparison to the current year's adopted budget. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

The 2010/2011 proposed annual budget includes an approximate 4.9% increase in water rates. This rate increase is primarily due to increased operating costs, decreasing average use and investment income.

2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on Anticipated Revenues, especially service charges and on the general purpose/component unit financial statements. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

Anticipated revenues for the 2010/2011 proposed budget will increase as compared to the current year's adopted budget, primarily related to the approximate 4.9% water rate increase noted above. The \$734,000 additional water revenues generated from the rate increase will allow coverage for increasing operating expenses. Bulk sales of \$1.2 million have a positive impact on the 2010/2011 budget.

3. Describe the state of the local/regional economy and how it may impact the proposed Annual Budget, including the planned Capital Budget/Program.

New customer growth is expected to be minimal. Despite the weaker economy, we anticipate minimal changes in average usage levels and base water revenues.

**4.** Describe the reasons for utilizing Unrestricted Net Assets in the proposed Annual Budget, i.e. rate stabilization, debt service reduction, to balance the budget, etc.

Unrestricted Net Assets will be used for rate stabilization and to balance the proposed 2010/2011 budget. Regarding OPEB liability, the Authority is utilizing a "pay as you go" approach for retirement benefit costs.

The 2010/2011 capital budget will financed primarily through Series 2002 bond funding, as well as internal funds. Debt service costs will remain relatively flat between fiscal years. Therefore, the 2010/2011 water capital budget will not impact rates.
