BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

March 22, 2010

A Resolution Awarding Contract for Electrical Work

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited bids for the supply of electrical work on an annual basis (hereinafter referred to as the "contract"); and

WHEREAS, bids have been solicited by the Authority for the contract in conformance with the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids were received by the Authority in response to the bid solicitation, as follows:

WHEREAS, the administrative and professional staff of the Authority have reviewed each of the bids submitted and find each to be acceptable as to form and content; and

WHEREAS, the Authority had considered the letter of protest from Sun Electrical Construction Corporation dated February 11, 2010 and, based upon the advice of the Authority Solicitor, has rejected that letter of protest for the reasons set forth in the accompanying letter from the Authority Solicitor dated March 19, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Frank Planko, Chief Financial Officer, has advised that Brick Utilities has sufficient funds in various Operating and Capital Accounts in the 2010/2011 Budget:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 22nd day of March, 2010, by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority, as follows:

1. The Authority accepts and approves the bids submitted by Statewide High-Way, Inc. and Sun Electrical Construction Corporation at the rates set forth hereinabove, with the understanding that all rates shall be at least the minimum prevailing wage rate as determined for the County of Ocean.

2. The Authority rejects the letter of protest from Sun Electrical Construction Corporation dated February 11, 2010. All bidders will be required to comply with the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Rate Rules and Regulations and shall be required to submit the appropriate Prevailing Wage Certification at the time of a request for payment.

3. The Chairman, Executive Director and Secretary of the Authority be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.


