BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

August 23, 2010

A Resolution Awarding Contract for the Annual Printing Services for Documents to PIP Printing

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited requests for qualifications for the annual printing services for documents (hereinafter referred to as the "contract"); and

WHEREAS, requests for qualifications have been solicited by the Authority for the contract in conformance with the provisions of the New Jersey Pay to Play Law, N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, and the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, two (3) bids were received by the Authority in response to the requests for qualifications, as follows:

Savio Enterprises	\$4,584.00
PIP Printing	\$4,695.00
Craftmaster Printing	\$5,666.00

WHEREAS, the proposal received by the apparent lowest applicant, Savio Enterprises, is \$111.00 less than the second lowest applicant, PIP Printing; and

WHEREAS, PIP Printing is an establishment located in Brick Township and is within closer proximity to the Authority, which in the long run will decrease the expense to the Authority for drop offs and pick ups, and

WHEREAS, the proposal from PIP Printing has been reviewed by the Authority's professional and administrative staff and found to be acceptable as to form and content; and

WHEREAS, the award of this contract to PIP Printing is in compliance with the Authority's budgetary constraints:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 23rd day of August, 2010, by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The contract for the annual document printing services is hereby awarded to PIP Printing, in an amount not to exceed \$4,695.00.00, in accordance with the bid itemization submitted, on an "as needed" basis, subject to its request for qualification unit pricing which is attached as Exhibit "A".

2. The proper officers of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority are hereby authorized to notify all bidders of the award of the contract.

3. The proper officers of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority are hereby authorized to execute the appropriate agreement with PIP Printing for these services.


4. The Chairman, Executive Director and Secretary of the Authority be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
