- 1. The amendments of the Family Medical Leave Act Policy, a copy of which are on file at the office of the Executive Director and can be reviewed during normal business hours, is hereby approved and adopted by the Authority.
- 2. All public agencies, employees and others required to be given notice of the adoption of this policy shall be sent certified copies of this Resolution and upon request, the policy, as amended, itself.
- 3. The Family Medical Leave Act Policy, as amended herein and adopted by this Resolution, shall be part of the Policies and Procedures Manual of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority.
- 4. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Executive Director, and Secretary to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
