

RESOLUTION NO. 32-12

THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

March 26, 2012

A Resolution for the Award of a Public Contract to National Water Main Cleaning Company in the Amount of \$976,620.60 for Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation – Phase VII, Contract No. 897087L, New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program (“NJEIFP”), Project No. S340448-06, Contract 4A

WHEREAS, The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (“Brick Utilities”) pursuant to Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et seq. duly advertised for bids for the Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation - Phase VII, Contract No. 897087L for the rehabilitation of approximately 3,909 LF of existing eight (8”) inch diameter A.C.P. sanitary sewer line, 1124 LF of ten (10”) inch diameter A.C.P. sanitary sewer line, 2387 LF of existing twelve (12”) inch diameter A.C.P. sanitary sewer line, by using the “Light Stream” or equal ultra-violet light cured-in-place pipeline reconstruction method. Also including approximately 1,039 LF of existing four (4”) inch diameter A.C.P./PVC sanitary sewer lateral line by using the “flex-liner” or equal cured-in-place pipeline reconstruction method as well as the rehabilitation of 76 existing active sewer service connections utilizing the “Lateral Connection Repair – Cap” units using the “Epros” or equal LCR liner system all of which have experienced corrosion and deterioration from hydrogen sulfide gas; and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids ranging in price from a low of \$976,620.60 to a high of \$1,455,553.20 were received pursuant to the advertisement and publicly opened on February 23, 2012 at 2:00 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, the two bids submitted have been reviewed by the Brick Utilities’ Counsel, Jerry J. Dasti, Esq., and the Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E.; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the bid submitted by the lowest bidder, National Water Main Cleaning Company, contains minor deviations of which the Brick Utilities’ Counsel has recommended be waived as they are inconsequential; and

WHEREAS, the Brick Utilities’ Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/ Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E., is recommending award of this Contract to National Water Main Cleaning Company, the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$976,620.60; and


WHEREAS, Frank Planko, Chief Financial Officer, has advised Brick Utilities that sufficient funds for the payment of \$976,620.60 are available and included in Project No. 897087L to be drawn from NJEIFP Series 2002.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRICK MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY as follows:

1. The Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation – Phase VII Contract No. 897087L is hereby awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, National Water Main Cleaning Company, in the amount of \$976,620.60 subject to all conditions outlined in the Notice to Bidders, Specifications and Contract Documents. This award is contingent upon Authorization-to-Award from the N.J. Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program; and
2. Brick Utilities accepts the recommendations of its Solicitor and waives the minor inconsistencies/deviations in the bid documents submitted by National Water Main Cleaning Company. They are minor in nature and do not adversely affect the bid process.
3. Brick Utilities finds the bid submitted by National Water Main Cleaning Company, the low bid, contains minor deviations and in accordance with the legal opinion and recommendation of legal counsel are hereby waived as the deviations are inconsequential; and
4. The Executive Director is authorized to return the bid bonds and other security received from the unsuccessful bidder within three (3) days after execution of the contract and to notify all bidders of the award of the contract; and
5. The proper officers of Brick Utilities are authorized to execute a contract with National Water Main Cleaning Company, 875 Summer Ave., Newark, NJ 07104 for this project; and
6. Said amount of \$976,620.60 shall be taken from Project No. 897087L for the payment of the obligation provided for herein.
