

RESOLUTION NO. 67-12

THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

November 26, 2012

A Resolution for the Award of Public Contract to A.C. Schultes, Inc. in the Amount of \$257,952.00 for Contract No. 712001, Redevelopment of Well No. 12

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") owns and operates a deep well known as Well No. 12, which was constructed in 1982 and had an initial yield of 2370 gallons per minute (gpm). The Well is 1,859 feet deep with a 12-inch diameter inner casing and an 18-inch diameter outer casing and withdraws water from the Potomac-Raritan-Magothy Aquifer; and

WHEREAS, Well No. 12 was last developed in May 2005, deep well redevelopment is recommended every 5 to 10 years and Well No. 12 was scheduled for redevelopment in Fiscal Year 2012/2013. Currently, the well's pumping capacity is approximately 2,170 gpm; and

WHEREAS, a complete redevelopment of Well No. 12 is necessary to assure the proper capacity of the well; and

WHEREAS, a weatherproof enclosure is also being constructed around Well No. 12 to protect the well from adverse weather conditions; and

WHEREAS, Brick Utilities pursuant to Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et seq. duly advertised for bids for Contract No. 712001 (Redevelopment of Well No. 12); and

WHEREAS, two (2) bids for Contract No. 712001 with prices of a low \$257,952.00 and a high of \$316,520.00 were received pursuant to the advertisement and publicly opened on November 8, 2012 at 2:00 P.M. EST; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted have been reviewed by Brick Utilities' Counsel, Jerry J. Dasti, Esq. and the Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E., and

WHEREAS, Stephen T. Specht, P.E., Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations is recommending the award of this Contract to A.C. Schultes, Inc., the low bidder in the amount of \$257,952.00; and

WHEREAS, A.C. Schultes, Inc., submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid of \$257,952.00; and


WHEREAS, Frank Planko, Chief Financial Officer, has advised Brick Utilities that sufficient funds for the payment of \$257,952.00 are accounted in Brick Utilities' Capital Plan within Project No. 712001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY as follows:

1. Brick Utilities awards the contract for this project to A.C. Shultes, Inc. for \$257,952.00; and
2. The Executive Director is authorized to return the bid bonds and other security received from the unsuccessful bidders within three days after execution of the contract and to notify all bidders of the award of the contract; and
3. The proper officers of Brick Utilities are authorized to execute a contract with A.C. Schultes, Inc., 664 S. Evergreen Avenue, Woodbury Heights, NJ 08097; and
4. Said amount of \$257,952.00 shall be taken from Project No. 712001 for the payment of the obligation provided for herein.
