A Resolution Authorizing Change Order No. 1 for a Decrease in the Contract Amount of \$37,565.52 to Sodon's Electric, Inc. for the Power Cable Replacement to the Raw Water Pump Station

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") did enter into a contract with Sodon's Electric, Inc., for work associated with the Power Cable Replacement to the Raw Water Pump Station was authorized by Resolution No. 24-13; and

WHEREAS, there has been a change of material for the use of an alternate power cable which has necessitated a change order; and

WHEREAS, said changes are shown on a document entitled Change Order No. 1 dated May 10, 2013; and

WHEREAS, said change order provides for a decrease of \$37,565.52 from the previously agreed upon contract amount of \$217,900.00 resulting in a new contract amount of \$180,334.48;

WHEREAS, the Authority and Sodon's Electric, Inc. have agreed to such changes; and

WHEREAS, said decreased amount is fair and reasonable and could not have been foreseen when the contract was advertised and awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht has reviewed this change order and is recommending that it be approved; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities as follows:

1. The contract between the Authority and Sodon's Electric, Inc. is amended and the change order entitled Change Order No. 1 dated May 10, 2013 may be executed by the officers and employees of the Authority upon an execution of such change order by the appropriate officials of Sodon's Electric, Inc.;
and
2. A certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to Sodon's Electric, Inc.
