A Resolution for the Award of a Public Contract to Municipal Maintenance Company, Inc. in the Amount of \$302,900.00 for the Alternate Bid for the Replacement of Flocculator Equipment in Sedimentation Basins Nos. 1 and 2; Capital Project No. 799008A

WHEREAS, The Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority ("Brick Utilities") pursuant to Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et seq. duly advertised for bids for the Replacement of Flocculator Equipment in Sedimentation Basins Nos. 1 and 2, Contract No. 799008A for the construction of modifications at the William Miller Jr. Water Treatment Plant for the removal and disposal of all existing equipment and the furnishing and installation of new equipment in the two existing flocculators No. 1 and No. 2, each of the size and configuration indicated on the drawings, including in general, flocculation equipment; concrete walkway repair; drive unit; motor and variable frequency drive unit (VFD) and controls; Motor Control Center (M.C.C.) modifications; miscellaneous demolitions and alterations; site work; together with all equipment, concrete work, miscellaneous metal work, electrical work, services of manufacturers' representatives, and other incidentals and appurtenant work indicated, specified or required for the proper completion of the contract.; and

WHEREAS, five (5) bids ranging in price from a low of \$201,800.00 and a high of \$323,000.00 for the Base Bid and from a low of \$302,900.00 and a high of \$448,000.00 for the Alternate Bid were received pursuant to the advertisement and publicly opened on April 23, 2013 at 2:00 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, the three (3) lowest bids submitted have been reviewed by the Brick Utilities' Counsel, Jerry J. Dasti, Esq., and the Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E.; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Maintenance Co., Inc. submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid of \$302,900.00; and

WHEREAS, the Brick Utilities' Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/ Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E., is recommending award of this Contract to Municipal Maintenance Co., Inc. the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$302,900.00; and


WHEREAS, Frank Planko, Chief Financial Officer, has advised Brick Utilities that sufficient funds for the payment of \$302,900.00 are available and included in Project No. 799008A; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRICK MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY as follows:

1. The Alternate Bid for the Replacement of Flocculator Equipment in Sedimentation Basins Nos. 1 and 2 is hereby awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Municipal Maintenance Co., Inc. in the amount of \$302,900.00 subject to all conditions outlined in the Notice to Bidders, Specifications and Contract Documents; and
2. The Executive Director is authorized to return the bid bonds and other security received from the unsuccessful bidder within three (3) days after execution of the contract and to notify all bidders of the award of the contract; and
3. The proper officers of Brick Utilities are authorized to execute a contract with Municipal Maintenance Company, Inc., 1352 Taylors Lane, Cinnaminson, NJ 08077 for this project; and
