

RESOLUTION NO. 68 - 13

BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

September 23, 2013

**A Resolution Rejecting all Bids for the Generator Replacement
At William Miller WTP Project**

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited bids for the generator replacement at the William Miller WTP (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has received eight (8) bids as listed on the attached tabulation; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's estimate received by the Authority in preparation of the bid solicitation indicates that the expected bid, without the alternatives, should not exceed \$2,199,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the apparent lowest responsible bidder has submitted a bid, without alternatives, approximately \$300,000.00 more than the estimate, and the second lowest bidder has submitted a bid approximately \$500,000.00 more than the engineer's estimate; and

WHEREAS, all of the bids submitted are outside the Authority's budgetary constraints, and therefore must be rejected.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 23rd day of September, 2013 by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Authority, based upon recommendations submitted from the Authority's Solicitor, rejects all bids as exceeding the Authority's budgetary constraints.
2. The Authority authorizes and directs its administrative and professional staff to immediately rebid the project so that bids can be received, reviewed and the bid can be awarded at the October meeting of the Authority.
2. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Executive Director, and Secretary to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded by the Administrative Secretary of the Authority to the following:
