THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

A Resolution for the Award of Public Contract to Steffen Drilling, LLC in the Amount of \$109,960.00 for Contract No. 799009C, Redevelopment of Cohansew Well Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, and 13

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") owns and operates seven (7) permitted shallow wells (Well Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 13) that are screened in the unconfined Cohansew/Kirkwood aquifer and are constructed to a depth between 48 and 70 feet, with original capacities varying from 150 to 250 gpm; and

WHEREAS, the Cohansew wells are overdue for redevelopment with respect to Brick Utilities' 5-year Well maintenance program; and

WHEREAS, the six (6) twelve-inches (12-in) Cohansew Wells (Well Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8) and one (1) twenty-four inches (24-in) Cohansew Well No. 13, will require complete redevelopment and pump replacements to increase capacities of the wells; and

WHEREAS, Brick Utilities pursuant to Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et seq. duly advertised for bids for Contract No. 799009C; and

WHEREAS, Four (4) bids, with prices of a low \$109,960.00 and a high of \$236,296.00 were received pursuant to the advertisement and publicly opened on November 14, 2013 at 2:00 P.M. EST; and

WHEREAS, the four (4) bids submitted have been reviewed by Brick Utilities' Counsel, Jerry J. Dasti, Esq. and the Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E., and

WHEREAS, Stephen T. Specht, P.E., Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations is recommending the award of this Contract to Steffen Drilling, the low bidder in the amount of \$109,960.00; and

WHEREAS, Steffen Drilling, LLC submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid of \$109,960.00; and


WHEREAS, Frank Planko, Chief Financial Officer, has advised Brick Utilities that sufficient funds for the payment of \$109,960.00 are accounted in Brick Utilities' Capital Plan within Project No. 799009C.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY as follows:

1. Brick Utilities awards the contract for this project to Steffen Drilling, LLC for \$109,960.00; and
2. The Executive Director is authorized to return the bid bonds and other security received from the unsuccessful bidders within three days after execution of the contract and to notify all bidders of the award of the contract; and
3. The proper officers of Brick Utilities are authorized to execute a contract with Steffen Drilling, LLC, P.O. Box, Glassboro, NJ 08028; and
4. Said amount of \$109,960.00 shall be taken from Project No. 799009C for the payment of the obligation provided for herein.
