

**RESOLUTION NO. 102- 14**

**BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY**

**October 27, 2014**

**A Resolution Awarding the Contract for the supply of Two (2) 2015 Low Pro Cab Chassis with Utility Body to Metropolitan Truck Sales, Inc. in the purchase amount of \$219,000.00**

**WHEREAS**, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited bids for the purchase of Two (2) 2015 Low Pro Cab Chassis with Utility Body; and

**WHEREAS**, bids for the contract have been solicited by the Authority in conformance with the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, three (3) bids were received in response to the bid solicitation, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the bid submitted by Metropolitan Truck Sales, Inc., the apparent lowest responsible bidder, has been reviewed by the Authority's solicitor and its administrative staff, and found to contain no material defects mandating rejection; and


**WHEREAS**, Brick Utilities Chief Financial Officer, Frank Planko, has advised that sufficient funds for the payment of \$219,000.00 are available to satisfy the Authority's payment obligation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** this 27<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2014 by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The Authority accepts the recommendations of the Authority's solicitor and administrative staff and awards the contract for this purchase to Metropolitan Truck Sales, Inc., and in consideration of \$219,000.00.
2. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Executive Director, and Secretary to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
