A Resolution Rejecting All Bids for the Purchase of Two (2) 2015 Low Pro Cab Chassis Trucks with Utility Body

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited bids for the purchase of two (2) 2015 Low Pro Cab Chassis Trucks with Utility Body (the "Trucks"); and

WHEREAS, bids for the contract have been solicited by the Authority in conformance with the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-1 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, three bids were submitted in response to the bid solicitation, as follows:

Schwartz Truck Center: \$232,706.00
Mid-Atlantic Truck Centre: \$244,720.00
Metropolitan Truck Sales: \$249,584.00

WHEREAS, the bids exceed the budgeted amount of \$230,000.00, and therefore the Authority does not have sufficient funds to award the purchase of the Trucks from the bidders; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted are not in compliance with the Authority's budgetary constraints:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 28th day of July, 2014, by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. The Authority rejects each bid submitted for the purchase of the Trucks. Each of the bids submitted are in excess of the Authority's budgetary constraints.
- 2. The Commissioners authorize the Authority staff to review the bid documentation and determine whether new bids should be solicited.
- 3. The Authority authorizes and directs the Chairman, Executive Director, and Secretary to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
- 4. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded by the Administrative Secretary of the Authority to the following:
