A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MASER CONSULTING PA TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT OF STORMWATER BMPs AT LAKE CARASALJO

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") operates and maintains a 16 MGD Water Treatment Plant, treating both surface and ground water from multiple sources; and

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") provides drinking water to more than one hundred thousand (100,000) residents of northern Ocean County and southern Monmouth County, and relies on the Metedeconk River for approximately seventy-five percent (75%) of its water supply; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is committed to the comprehensive management and protection of its raw water sources; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (the "NJDEP") recognized the Authority's watershed protection efforts and allocated grant funding to the Authority for the development and implementation of the Metedeconk River Watershed Protection and Restoration Plan (the "Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority worked closely with the Metedeconk watershed municipalities, Ocean and Monmouth Counties, and other stakeholders to develop the Plan, which was finalized and approved by NJDEP on May 23, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies projects and other measures to address existing water quality impairments and safeguard the Metedeconk River as a water supply source, major Barnegat Bay tributary, and environmentally sensitive and important regional water resource; and

WHEREAS, one of the remedial measures identified in the Plan is the design and construction of stormwater BMPs at Lake Carasaljo; and

WHEREAS, the Authority requires professional services for the development of this model ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the fees for the required professional services will be reimbursable with allocated grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Authority requested that its Alternate Engineers submit proposals to provide professional services for the design and construction of stormwater BMPs at Lake Carasaljo; and

WHEREAS, Proposals were received on March 6th and proposal prices were as follows: Maser \$79,505, French and Parello \$113,800, CME \$190,000, PS&S \$207,695, and H2M \$321,000, and

WHEREAS, after a review of the proposals by Authority staff it was determined that Maser Consulting PA met the requirements of the Request for Proposals, and

WHEREAS, the Authority appointed Maser Consulting, PA as an Alternate Consulting Engineer via a fair and open process; and

WHEREAS, Maser Consulting, PA has demonstrated the qualifications and experience necessary to successfully complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's legal counsel has advised that once appointed, via a fair and open process for a specific term, the consulting engineers and alternate consulting engineers may be tasked additional items during the term of their contract; and

WHEREAS, the proposed work constitutes "professional services" and is exempt from the public bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law at N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Chief Financial Officer, Frank Planko, has advised that sufficient funds to undertake this project are accounted for in the Authority's Capital Plan within Project No. 797101.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY as follows:

- 1) A contract to provide Professional Services to Complete the above referenced project in accordance with their Proposal dated March 6, 2015 and in the amount of \$79,505 is assigned to Maser Consulting, PA, is awarded to Maser Consulting, PA of 331 Newman Springs Road, Suite 203, Red Bank, NJ 07701; and
- 2) A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to Maser Consulting, PA.
