WHEREAS, the Authority has previously appointed Maser Consulting, P.A. via a fair and open process as its consulting engineer; and

WHEREAS, the award of this consulting engineer agreement is a professional contract and therefore exempt from the formal bidding requirements set forth in the New Jersey Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Chief Financial Officer, Frank Planko has advised the Authority that sufficient funds for the payment of \$11,840.00 does exist; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- The above referenced contract be awarded to Maser Consulting, P.A., 331 Newman Springs Road, Red Bank, New Jersey; and
- 2. Brick Utilities Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute an agreement for these services subsequent to the execution of said agreement by Maser Consulting, P.A.
