

**RESOLUTION NO. (23-17)**

**BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY**

**February 27, 2017**

**A Resolution Awarding Bid for Water Treatment Chemicals**

**WHEREAS**, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") has solicited bids for the supply of water treatment chemicals for Fiscal Year 2017/2018 [April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2018]; and

**WHEREAS**, Alternate bids were requested for the supply of Liquid Alum and Sodium Hydroxide through Fiscal Year 2018/2019 [April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2019]; and

**WHEREAS**, bids have been solicited by the Authority for the project in conformance with the provisions of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, the bids have been carefully reviewed by Joseph Maggio, P.E., Director of Water Quality, as well as by the Authority Solicitor, and a recommendation has been made to the Commissioners by Director Maggio as to the lowest responsible bidder for each of the chemicals, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the low bid for Zinc Orthophosphate (\$57,492) has been rejected as materially nonresponsive to the specification requirement that the source of zinc be zinc oxide;

**WHEREAS**, the bid documentation submitted by each of the apparent lowest responsible bidders for each of the particular chemical supplies has been reviewed by Director Maggio and the Authority Solicitor and has been found acceptable as to form and content, and is in compliance with the bid specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, The 2 year bid price for Liquid Alum has been found to be favorable to the Authority and it is recommended that a 2 year contract be awarded for the supply of Liquid Alum; and

**WHEREAS**, John Clifford, Chief Financial Officer, has advised Brick Utilities that funding for the purchase of the aforesaid chemicals have been included in the 2017/2018 Authority Operating Budget, Account Number 701-8330; and

**WHEREAS**, any 2017/2018 budget overrun for chemicals will be accounted from within other 2017/2018 operating accounts:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** this 27th day of February, 2017, by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

1. The contracts for the chemicals be and hereby are awarded as hereinabove set forth, subject to all conditions outlined in the Notice to Bidders and Specifications.

2. The Chairman and Executive Director and Secretary of the Authority be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.

3. The Executive Director be and hereby is authorized to return the bid bonds and other security received from the unsuccessful bidders within three (3) days after execution of the contracts, and to notify all bidders of the award of the these contracts.
