A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 08-18 FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN INDUCTIVELY COUPLED PLASMA MASS SPECTROMETER FROM AGILENT TECHNOLGIES THROUGH STATE CONTRACT T0115 PROJECT 710036A, AMOUNT \$130,564.56

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") owns an Inductively Coupled Plasma Mass Spectrometer (ICPMS) used for metals analysis which equipment is well beyond it useful life and has become unreliable and difficult to repair due to the unavailability of spare parts causing disruptions in laboratory workflow; and

WHEREAS, the Authority requested and received a proposal from Agilent Technologies to furnish a new ICPMS in the amount of \$130,564.56; and

WHEREAS, the proposal requires the Authority to transfer ownership of the ICPMS currently owned by the Authority to Agilent Technologies; and

WHEREAS, the Authority via Resolution No. 08-18 authorized the purchase of an ICPMS from Agilent Technologies through State Contract T0115; and

WHEREAS, Agilent Technologies' State Contract T0115 expired prior to procurement by the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the application for renewal of a State Contract by Agilent Technologies has been timely filed but is still pending (not yet approved); and

WHEREAS, procurement through an approved New Jersey State Contract pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:11-1 et seq. is an exception to the Local Public Contracts Law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 29th day of March, 2018, by the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. Resolution 08-18 for the purchase of an ICPMS from Agilent Technologies through State Contract T0115 is hereby rescinded.
- 2. The Chairman and Executive Director and Secretary of the Authority be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all necessary documents in order to implement the intent of this resolution.
