THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

A Resolution for Approving and Authorizing the Award of a Contract to Pillari Bros Construction Corp. in the amount of \$438,932.22 for the Replacement of Manholes on Princeton Avenue, Contract No. 817002

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2018, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority") pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., advertised for bids for the Replacement of Manholes on Princeton Avenue, Contract No. 817002 for rehabilitation by complete replacement of five (5) existing sanitary sewer manholes of approximately eight (8') feet, nine (9') feet, two (2) - sixteen (16') feet and eighteen (18') feet depth with precast PVC lined manholes and associated work on Princeton Avenue (CR 630) of Brick Township; and

WHEREAS, five bids ranging in price a low of \$438,932.22 to a high of to \$1,895,855.59 were received pursuant to the advertisement and publicly opened on May 15, 2018 at 2:00 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, submitted bids have been reviewed by the Authority's Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E. and the Authority's Counsel, Ben A. Montenegro, Esq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E. noted no irregularities with the bid received from Pillari Bros Construction Corp. as part his review of all of the bids; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E. is recommending the award of this Contract to Pillari Bros Construction Corp., the lowest bidder, in the amount of \$438,932.22; and


WHEREAS, Brick Utilities' Chief Financial Officer, John Clifford, has advised Brick Utilities that sufficient funds for the payment of \$438,932.22 do exist for Capital Project No. 817002 in the Authority's Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Capital Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY as follows:

1. The Replacement of Manholes on Princeton Avenue, Contract No. 817002 is hereby awarded to the low bidder, Pillari Bros Construction Corp., in the amount of \$438,932.22 subject to all conditions outlined in the Notice to Bidders, Specifications and Contract Documents; and
2. The Authority's Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E. has recommended to the Authority that Pillari Bros Construction Corp. as the low bidder be awarded the Contract; and
3. The Authority's Deputy Executive Director and Director of Engineering/Operations, Stephen T. Specht, P.E. is authorized to return the bid bonds and other security received from the unsuccessful bidders within three (3) days after execution of the contract and to notify all bidders of the award of the contract; and
4. The Authority's Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the Pillari Bros Construction Corp., 65 Squankum Yellowbrook Road, Farmingdale, NJ for this project; and
5. Said amount of \$438,932.22 shall be funded from Capital Project No. 817002 for the payment of the obligation provided for herein; and
