THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

A RESOLUTION NOT OBJECTING TO A PROPOSED USE OF SHARED FIBER BY THE BRICK TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AND BRICK TOWNSHIP AND SEPARATE SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY AND THE BRICK BOARD OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the Brick Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as the “Authority”) has entered into a Shared Service Agreement with the Township of Brick, dated 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has entered into a Shared Service Agreement with the Brick Township Board of Education, dated 2012; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the two (2) Shared Service Agreements, each party, to wit, the Authority, the Township of Brick and the Board of Education, each have use of eight (8) separate fiber cables each. Brick Township Police Department is to establish two (2) duplex fiber optic cable circuits to support their Motorola Radio Network which proposals will a) interact and affect the Brick Township Board of Education and b) permit the Brick Township Police Department to make use of the fibers that are allocated for use by Brick Township; and

WHEREAS, the Brick Memorial High School circuit would likewise make use of fiber allocated for use by Brick Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick and the Brick Board of Education have each acknowledged and approved said extension by the Brick Township Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Director Gary Vaccaro and Ben Gabriele, the Authority’s Fiber Manager, have reviewed and recommend approval of such activity by the Brick Township Police Department.


