**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A COVID-19 APPRECIATION AWARD FOR
THE BRICK TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the Authority is desirous of compensating those employees who demonstrated extra effort by way of on-site working hours during the COVID-19 pandemic during the period in which the State of New Jersey was ordered to remain home; and

WHEREAS, more specifically, the Authority shall award to eligible employees compensatory time for performing on-site working hours during the twelve (12) week period initiated on March 21, 2020, the date in which Executive Order 107 was executed by the Governor of the State of New Jersey requiring New Jersey residents to stay home, with exceptions related to essential operations; and

WHEREAS, such compensatory time must be pre-approved and shall be used during the year 2022 only, or be lost. In addition, such compensatory time awarded shall hold no cash-value, shall not be subject to conversion to overtime compensation and shall not be subject to any contractual agreements related to time bank caps and/or allotments; and

WHEREAS, the Authority shall award one (1) compensatory day for every one-hundred (100) on-site hours worked per eligible employee during the twelve (12) week period noted above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Brick Township MUA at the meeting held on December 29, 2021, that the COVID-19 Appreciation Award Compensation hereby is adopted.
