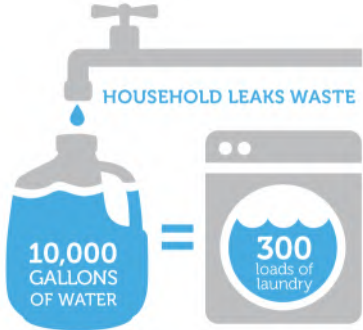
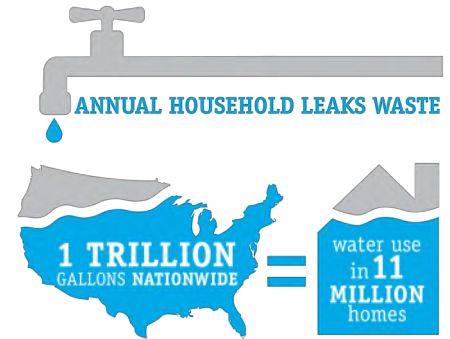

Take the 10-Minute Leak Challenge

Check for dripping faucets, worn gaskets or valves, and twist on an aerator.

Take the 10-Minute Leak Challenge

Tighten showerhead connections with a wrench and pipe tape.

Take the 10-Minute Leak Challenge

Drop food coloring in the tank and replace the flapper if color shows in the bowl.

Take the 10-Minute Leak Challenge

Check for broken spray heads and leaks at sprinkler and hose connections.
